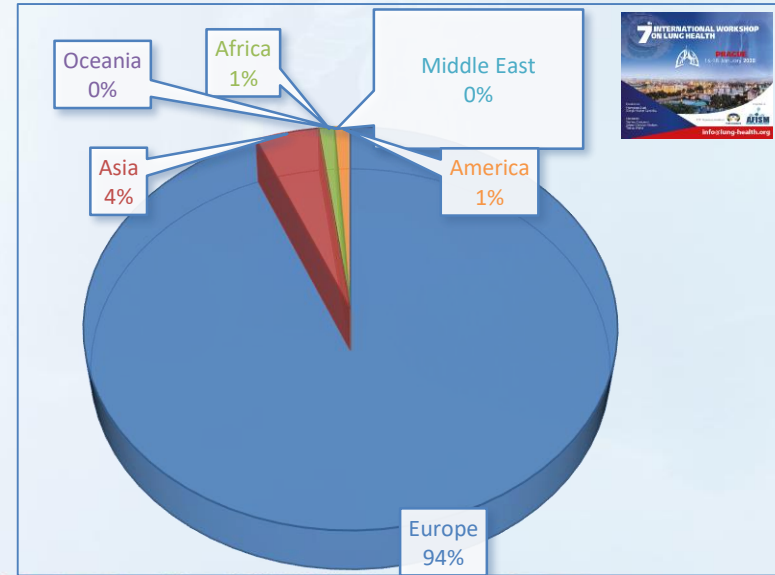

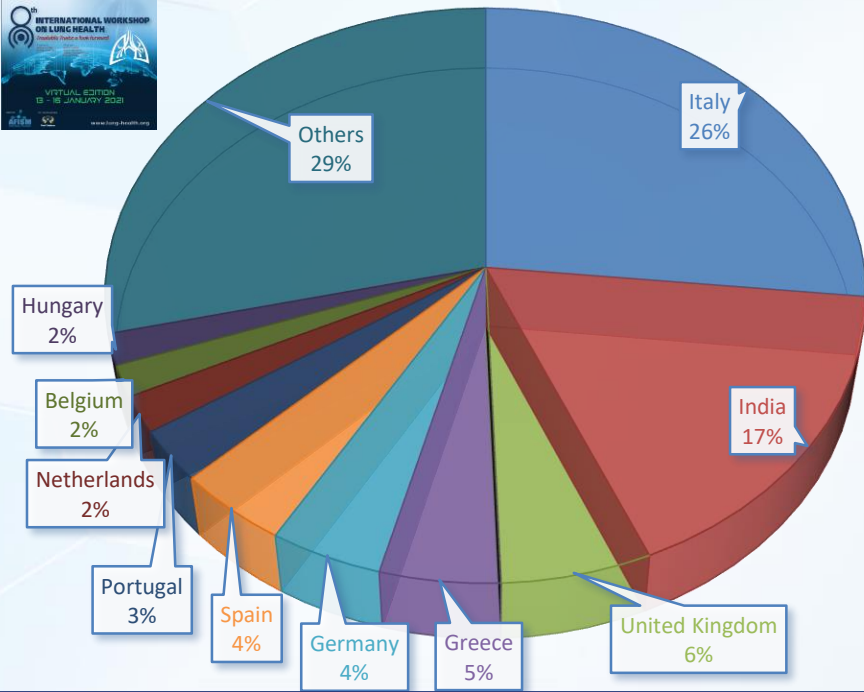

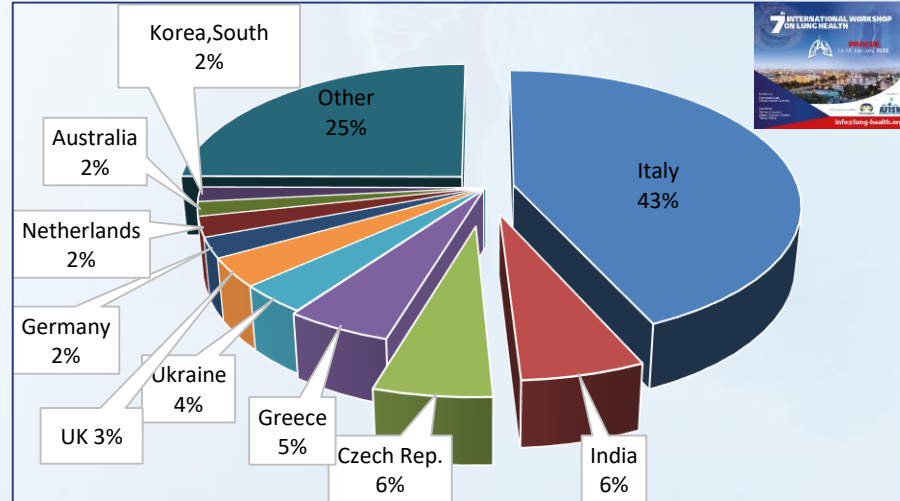
PARTICIPANTS BY CONTINENT



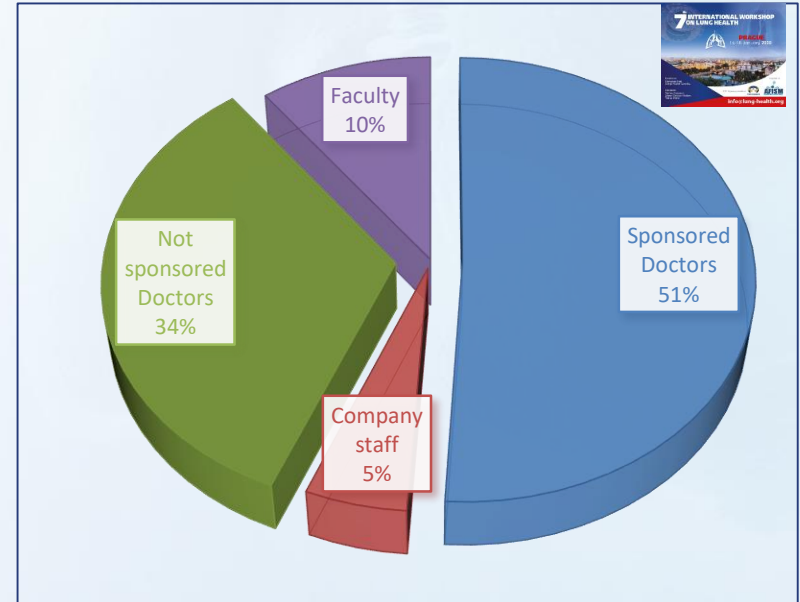
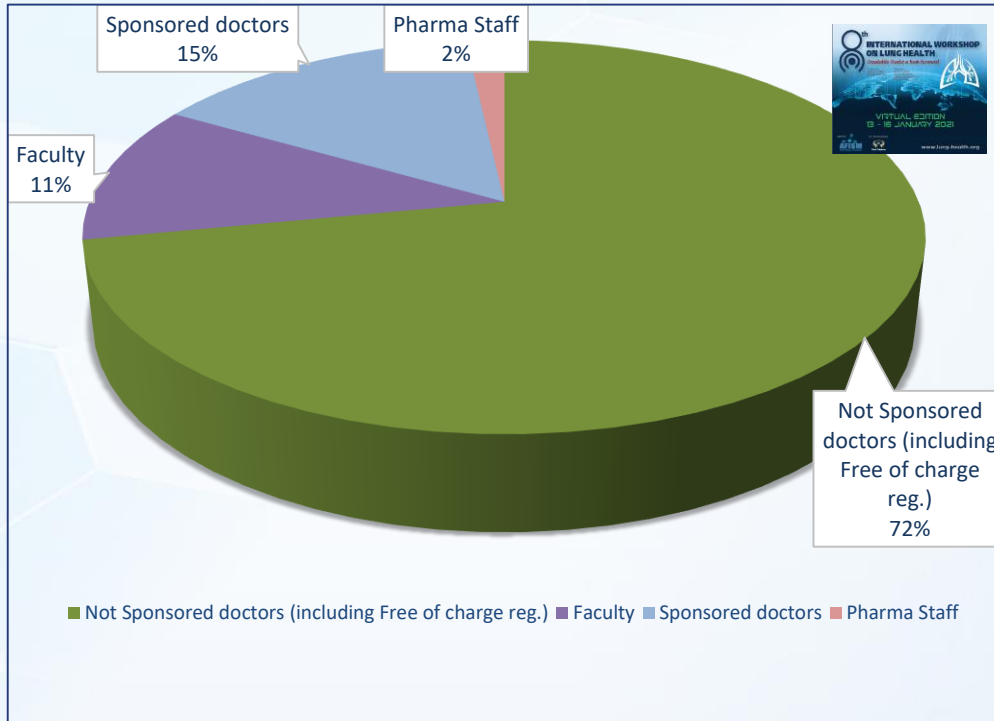
PARTICIPANTS BY COUNTRY

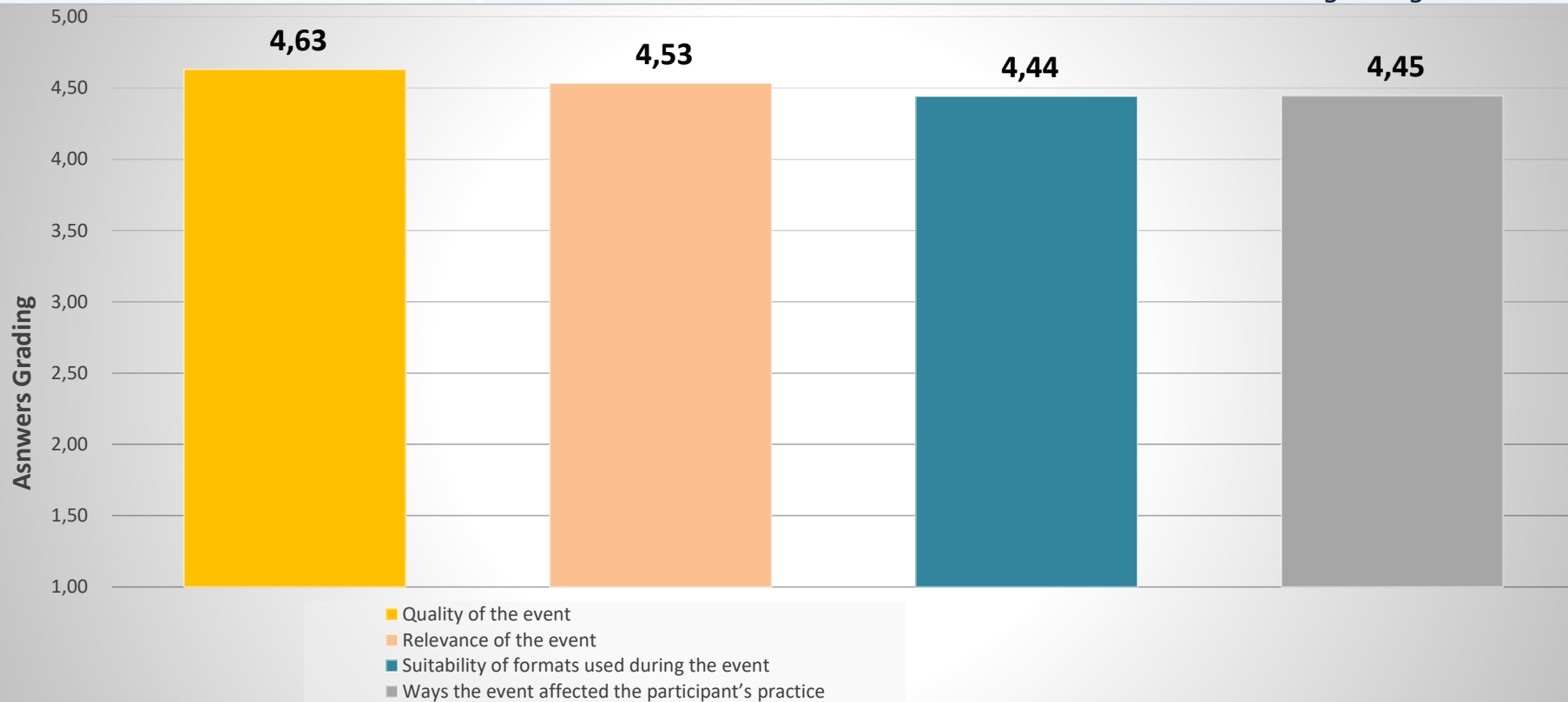


PARTICIPANTS BY REGISTRATION TYPE

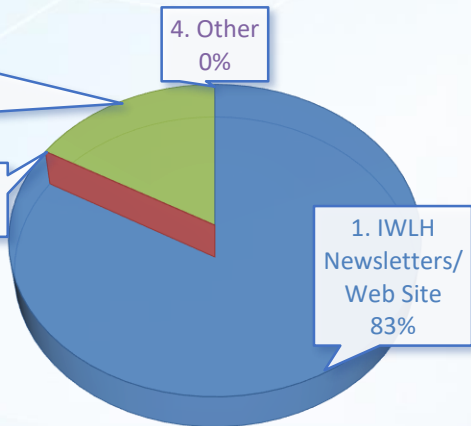

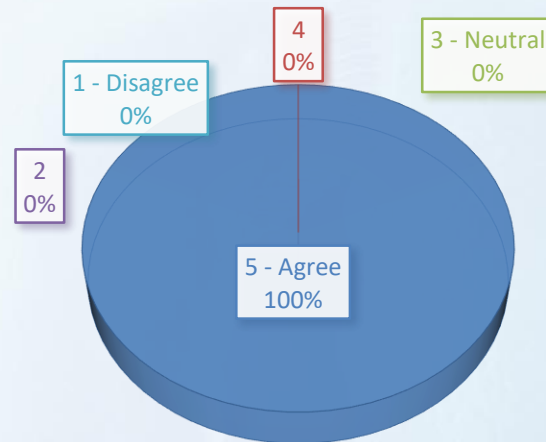

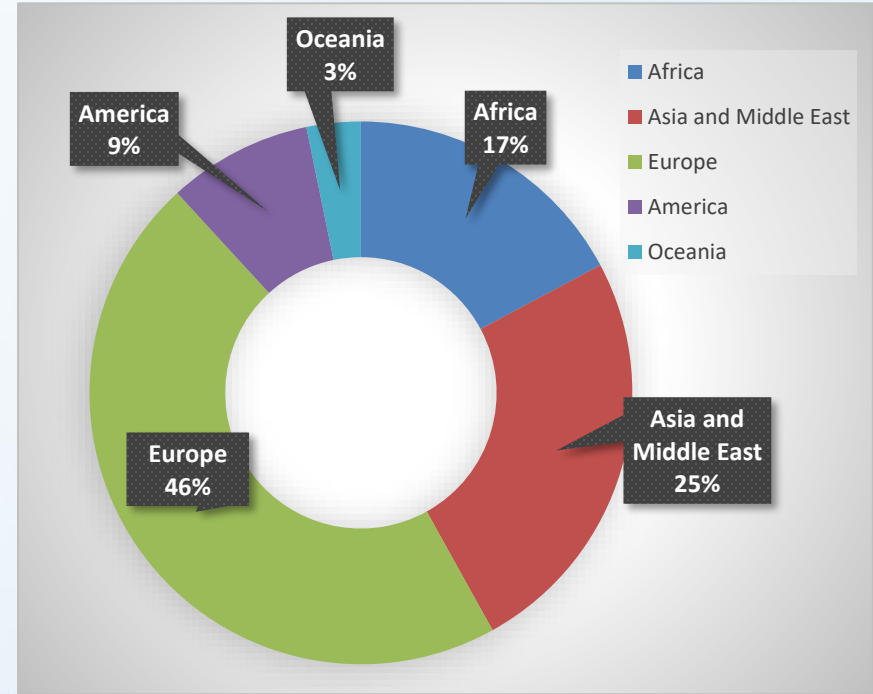
